Overall Responsibilities

Senior consultants at Stratos are responsible for providing high quality consulting services to existing clients and contributing to business development activities with new, previous, and existing clients. While senior consultants will be primarily aligned with a particular Stratos line of business based on their identifiable area(s) of professional expertise, they will also support other lines of business as required. The Senior Technical Consultant's primary role is to contribute to projects that involve technical subject matter, technical methodologies, or other areas requiring understanding of complex systems. - Providing technical and analytical expertise and advice around a specific discipline or knowledge area, including:
 - Analyze technical/specialist issues, and synthesize multiple sources of potentially conflicting information to understand and assess problems



- Conduct research and analysis, applying technical experience, knowledge and established assessment frameworks and approaches, and
- Assist and or lead in the development and application of methodologies and best practices related to specific technical areas.
- Managing projects, including:
 - Managing work plan execution;
 - Tracking actual expenditures versus budget;
 - Supervising project team members; and
 - Client liaison.
- Contributing to the successful completion of specific consulting engagements by:
 - Conducting web-based research and literature reviews;
 - Compiling, synthesizing and analysing information, including analysis of research work completed by others;
 - Conducting consultation and information collection activities, including leading interviews, surveys, and some broader consultation activities;
 - Leading the analysis and writing of project reports;
 - Preparing and making presentations; and
 - Leading meetings.
- Engaging in some business development and marketing activities, including:
 - Developing a network of professional contacts, and working to expand this network over time;
 - Identifying potential business opportunities through networks and existing project work;
 - Contributing to and, in some cases, managing preparation of solicited and unsolicited proposals; and
 - Bringing in a small number of projects each year.
- Contributing to the successful operation of the firm by:
 - Adhering to Stratos policies and procedures
 - Participating in internal teams and committees, and
 - Learning about the consulting business, and applying these learnings.

Education

Engineering degree or other applied science degree (e.g. geology), either Masters and/or Undergraduate level, required in a discipline related to natural resource management or sustainability; some relevant work experience (e.g. 6 - 8 years of related experience) will be seen as a strong asset.

- Good interpersonal and communication skills, as evidenced by clear and respectful communications with colleagues and clients
- Ability to conduct information collection interviews effectively
- Ability to identify clear decisions or recommendations that may emerge from meeting discussions and/or interview notes
- Very good writing skills, including ability to undertake technical writing that is accessible to a general audience
- Good presentation skills
- Good time management and organizational skills
- Ability to manage projects, including developing and monitoring budgets, timelines and product quality
- Good project planning and organizational skills
- Working knowledge of French would be an asset.
